

The Continuum Project – House Rules & Resident Agreement

Overview

The Continuum Project provides structured Single Residential Occupancy (SRO) housing designed to support stability, accountability, and successful community reintegration.

Curfew Policy

Residents must comply with curfew requirements established by their supervising probation or parole officer. If none has been assigned, a standard 10:00 PM curfew may apply.

Mandatory Check-Ins

- Participate in regular check-ins with program management.
- Maintain communication regarding employment, appointments, and supervision requirements.
- Immediately report changes in employment, supervision status, or income.

Respect & Conduct Expectations

- Treat fellow residents, neighbors, and staff with respect.
- Harassment, threats, intimidation, and disruptive behavior are prohibited.
- Respect quiet hours and maintain cleanliness.

Drug & Violence Policy

- Zero-tolerance policy regarding illegal drugs.
- Possession, use, or distribution of illegal substances is prohibited.
- Violence, threats, or possession of weapons is prohibited.
- Violations may result in immediate removal and notification of authorities.

Program Participation Expectations

- Maintain a verifiable source of income.
- Actively work toward stability and independence.
- Comply with all probation, parole, or supervision requirements.
- Follow all house policies.

Resident Agreement

By residing in The Continuum Project housing, residents acknowledge that they understand and agree to follow all house rules and program expectations. Failure to follow these rules may result in disciplinary action or removal from the residence.
