

The Continuum Project – Housing Details Sheet

Housing Environment

Residents are provided with a private bedroom within a shared residential home. Common areas such as the kitchen, living room, bathroom, and other shared spaces are communal and must be maintained respectfully by all residents. The home is structured to provide a stable and respectful environment for individuals working toward long-term independence.

Number of Residents

The residence houses a maximum of three (3) residents at any given time. Maintaining a small number of residents allows for a more controlled, respectful, and supportive living environment.

House Rules

- Residents must conduct themselves respectfully and responsibly at all times.
- Maintain cleanliness in private rooms and shared spaces.
- Comply with all probation, parole, or supervision requirements.
- Maintain a verifiable source of income (employment, SSI, SSDI, VA benefits, retirement income, or other approved sources).
- Maintain peaceful coexistence with other residents.
- Violence, threats, harassment, or illegal activity will result in immediate removal.
- Respect quiet hours.
- Follow all program expectations promoting stability, responsibility, and independence.

Curfew

Curfew requirements will be determined by the supervising probation or parole officer.

Drug and Alcohol Policy

The Continuum Project maintains a strict zero-tolerance policy regarding illegal drugs and unauthorized substance use. Violations may result in immediate removal and notification of the supervising authority.

Visitor Policy

Visitors are limited and must be approved in advance. Overnight guests are not permitted.

Transportation Access

The residence is located approximately a 20-minute walk from the nearest public bus stop.
